6. For our servicemen and women who have made the ultimate sacrifice to preserve justice and peace; and for all the recently deceased, we pray.
7. That all scouts take seriously their commitment to the Scout Oath and the Scout Law as ways of demonstrating their love of God and each other, we pray.
8. Now, in the quiet of our hearts, let us place before the Lord our own needs. (Pause) We pray.
