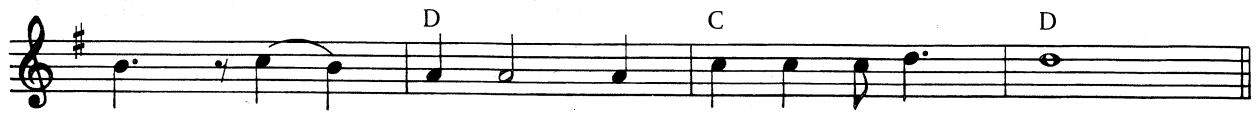
REFRAIN

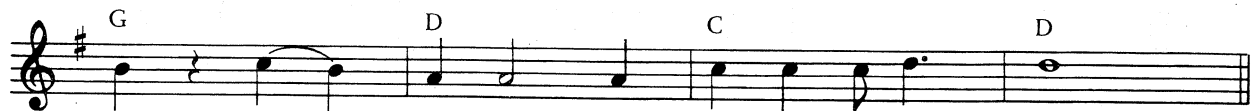

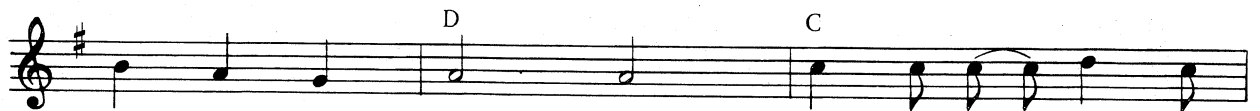

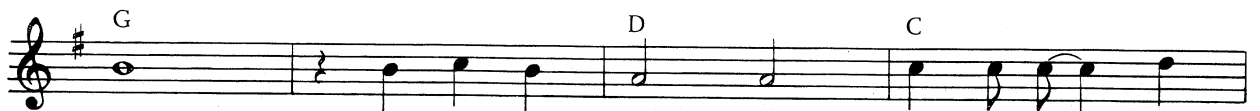
